Cross Paths In the weeks leading up to Good Friday and Easter, both morning and evening sermons will follow through the gospel narrative of Jesus' last meal, arrest, trial and crucifixion. The mornings will follow Matthew's account; the evenings will follow Luke's.

These narratives are sombre, serious and highly significant. Behind what appears to be a tragic miscarriage of justice, we see the sovereign hand of God bringing out the extraordinary atoning death of Jesus for the salvation of the world.

This series will help us understand the most important event in history and entice us to trust in Jesus' saving death. Pray that God's word deeply touches you in these weeks so that Good Friday is truly good for you and Easter Day is a sincere celebration of the gift of eternal, resurrection life.
